By signing this application, the Applicant, on behalf of the project owner, hereby grants to the District and its employees, consultants, and contractors the right to enter its property to undertake such activities that the District determines are necessary for processing the Applicant's request. Applicant agrees to install the water system improvements in accordance with the requirements of Diablo Water District. Applicant agrees to pay, within 15 days of receipt of invoice, all personnel and related direct and indirect costs associated with the Applicant's project including District staff costs for engineering, administration and inspection, which shall include, but not be limited to, the salary and benefits earned by each District employee, contract employee, or contractor for each hour or fraction of an hour that the employee is engaged in working in connection with the facilities, plus a 30 percent overhead charge. Use of the District's vehicles shall be charged at the then current Caltrans equipment rental rates. Services of consulting engineers and attorneys shall be charged at cost. Applicant further agrees to increase the initial deposit by the amount determined by the District within 15 days of being notified of the required deposit increase. Applicant understands and agrees that until a fully executed Facilities Installation Agreement is completed, if required by the District, a binding agreement to permit the project to proceed does not exist.

Diablo Water District Drought Restrictions for New Building Landscapes
Effective May 15, 2015

1) The use of potable water to irrigate the landscaping outside newly constructed homes or buildings shall not exceed an average of five (5) gallons per hundred square feet of front yard landscape area per day over seven consecutive days during the months of April through November and shall not exceed an average of one and one half (1.5) gallons per hundred square feet of front yard landscape area per day over seven consecutive days during the months of December through March. The aforementioned quantities include a 25 percent allowance for plant establishment. The General Manager may, but is under no obligation to, provide an additional amount of water based on water efficient irrigation calculations submitted to the District no later than June 8, 2015, based on a landscape plan utilizing no more than 60 percent moderate water use plants and no less than 40 percent low water use plants with an overall plant density of 50 percent in the landscape area;

2) Irrigation with potable water of landscapes outside of newly constructed homes and buildings shall be by drip or microspray and in a manner not in conflict with the regulations or other requirements established by the California Building Standards Commission and have been issued a building permit after May 15, 2015;

3) Watering of outdoor ornamental landscape more than three days per week and more than two times on those days is prohibited;

4) Watering outdoor landscapes during and up to 48 hours after measurable precipitation is prohibited;

5) The application of water to outdoor landscapes in a manner that causes runoff such that water flows onto adjacent property, non-irrigated area, private and public walkways, roadways, parking lots, or structures is prohibited;

6) The application of water to any hard surface; including but not limited to driveways, sidewalks, and asphalt is prohibited; and

7) Excessive water use in any one day is prohibited.
