REGULATION NO. 11

CARBON NEUTRALITY

Section I. Purpose and Authority

- A. The purpose of this regulation is to establish the District's requirement to be carbon neutral in its operations, buildings, transmission and treatment of water, fleet, and all other tangible business operations under its direct control. The District has adopted Resolution No. 2021-17 requiring net zero carbon emissions by the end of calendar year 2027, meaning a full offset of current and future emissions.

Section II. Applicability

- A. This regulation applies to current District facilities and operations and to new facilities and operations as they may come to exist in the future.

Section III. Requirements

- A. Existing facilities, operations, fleet, etc.
1. The District shall annually reduce its carbon emissions.
 2. Annually, projects shall be budgeted and funded that will help meet the year 2027 deadline.
- B. New facilities.
1. Offset calculations for solar or equivalent, require the developer of the District facility to produce 110% of the estimated annual energy

consumption of the site.

2. Energy is defined as the sum of estimated kWhs, therms, fuel, etc. (i.e., sources of greenhouse gas emissions).
3. Developers of new District facilities will be required to install solar onsite and/or pay into a District fund (via Facility Reserve Charges), so the District may install solar at one of its existing locations.
